→ SHOW CONDUCT AND INFORMATION →

Every class offered at this show that is covered by the IHJA Rules will be conducted and judged in accordance with those rules found at www.jumpclub.org.

Show management expects sportsmanlike conduct and behavior from exhibitors, trainers, and spectators and reserves to itself the right to refuse, limit, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries; disqualify any riders or exhibitors thereby canceling awarded prizes; change any course; cancel or combine any unfilled classes; change rings or officials; reschedule classes after due notice to exhibitors; change specifications in jumper classes as competition warrants and intercept all questions and conditions in regard to, or arising out of, or incident to the show without claims for damages or recourse of any kind. All entry forms must be accompanied by a signed release. BSJC and members of show staff will not be responsible for loss or damage to any person, animal, property, or equipment, and each exhibitor shall assume all liability for any loss, damage, or injury to any person, animal, property, or equipment that may be caused by them or due to carelessness or negligence of any of their subordinates or supervisors. Every entry shall constitute an agreement that the rider and the horse shall be subject to the IHJA rules, the Idaho Horse Park rules, and the rules of the BSJC Summer Spectacular as contained herein or otherwise noticed. USEF Rules will govern in the absence of an IHJA rule on point. Interruptions of procedure for storms, accidents or other emergencies will be governed by USEF Rule GR 31 I, and NO REFUNDS OR CREDITS WILL BE PROVIDED FOR CANCELLATIONS DUE TO STORMS, ACCIDENTS OR OTHER EMERGENCIES.

Show Management reserves the right to remove any person from the competition grounds for failing to exercise good manner of sport or engaging in behavior endangering the safety of welfare of others, as determined by show management in its sole discretion.

Please leave your dogs at home. Idaho Horse Park rules presently require that all dogs must be leashed at all times for the safety of exhibitors and spectators.

→ SCHOOLING →

There will be one schooling ring for each arena, and a lunging area. Hunter riders should school in the hunter schooling ring and jumper riders should school in the jumper schooling ring, in order to avoid schooling ring congestion. For the safety of those mounted, there will be no lunging in the schooling rings.

→ PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR →

All exhibitors are required to wear properly fitting headgear when jumping on the show grounds. Additionally, all headgear must be worn with harness secured. Show management encourages all riders to wear protective headgear meeting or surpassing current applicable ASTM standards with harness secured while riding anywhere on the show grounds.

→ EXCERPTS FROM USEF JUMPER RULES →

Table II, Sec. 1. Time First Round—The first round is decided by adding together the faults incurred over the course and any penalties for exceeding the Time Allowed. Horses with clean rounds or equal faults are classified according to their time taken to complete the course.

Table II, Sec. 2 (b) Time first jump-off —The first round and first jump-off, if any, are decided by adding together the faults incurred over the course and any penalties for exceeding the Time Allowed. If a competitor has gone clean in the first round, the competitor will, without leaving the ring, upon an audible signal, commence the designated jump-off course. If there are no clean rounds and a tie exists for first place, there will be one jump-off in which time will decide in the event of equality of faults.

Table II, Sec. 2 (c)—Two Phase Competitions - If a competitor has gone clean in the first round, he will, upon crossing the finish line, commence the designated jump-off course. Time starts as the horse crosses the finish line for the initial course. If there are no clean rounds and a tie exists for first place, there will be one jump-off, in which time will decide in the event of equality of faults.

Table IV Sec. 1 - Optimum Time in First Round —The first round is decided by adding together the faults incurred over the course and any penalties for exceeding the Time Allowed. In the case of equality of faults, ties will be broken on the following basis: an “Optimum Time” (defined as 4 seconds less than the Time Allowed for the course) will be posted on the course plan; the horse with the time on course closest to this Optimum Time (over or under) will prevail in the tie, next closest next, etc.

→ ADDS & POST ENTRIES →

Class adds at the show may be made at the show office on the official form and must be initialed by the competitor, or prior to the show by letter. All class adds must be received prior to the start of the class. **NO CLASS ADDS WILL BE ALLOWED AT THE GATE!** Class adds after the closing date for entries (June 24, 2010) will be assessed a \$5 late fee per class in addition to the class entry fee. Entries received after the closing date for entries will be assessed a \$5 late fee per class in addition to the class entry fee. Encouraging pre-entries helps show management **BETTER** regulate and alter the schedule as entries warrant and will allow the show to run more efficiently.

→ STABLING →

Stalls must be arranged through the Idaho Horse Park on-line at <http://www.idahohorsepark.com/Reservations.htm>. Day stalls are available for \$60 for 3 nights or \$80 for 4 nights. If you require shavings please order when making your stall reservation. Early or late stabling may be arranged through the Horse Park for an additional fee. **ADVANCE RESERVATIONS WILL SPEED YOUR CHECK-IN.** For safety and consideration, Show Management encourages all horses and ponies to have a stall. Shavings must be purchased through Idaho Horse Park.

→ BRAIDING OPTIONAL →

Braiding is optional at this show and no entry will be penalized if the horse is not braided.

→ WEDNESDAY WARM-UPS→

9 AM to 5 PM

Both arenas will be open for warm up Friday beginning at 9:00 am.

Warm-ups cost \$25 and will follow an open format. Gate personnel will control the number of riders in each arena as warranted. Warm-up may be limited to 4 horses/riders and 4 people in the ring at one time.
